6 Main Stops

1. From Sami port at 9:00 a.m. to Nisopoulo in Pera Pigadi.

Explore the crystal-clear waters and watch the fish with a mask and snorkel while your meal is freshly prepared onboard. Please note that masks and snorkels are not provided, so be sure to bring your own!

We offer a traditional 'Riganada' (bread with tomato, olive oil, oregano, and stouba), refreshing watermelon, assorted juices, and plenty of cold water—all in unlimited quantities! Enjoy as much as you want of everything we offer.

2. To Filiatro, a small beach for our second swim. Its blue waters and impressive rocks create a magical landscape.



3. Enjoy a scenic boat ride around Lazaretto, the charming islet in the center of Vathi's port, perfect for capturing beautiful photos.

On the way, we cruise close to caves and cliffs, offering stunning views of Ithaca's rugged beauty!

4. We will stop at the port of Vathi for coffee and a visit to its picturesque alleys, hosting small shops, where locals offer excellent handmade products.
